#### **DETERMINE QUORUM; CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Lents noted that a quorum was present and called the meeting to order. She advised that the meeting was being recorded.

#### Receive comments or questions from the public

The next item on the agenda was to receive comments and questions from the public. There were no comments from the public.

#### CONSENT AGENDA

- a. Approval of the Authority minutes of October 28, 2021;
- b. Approval of the Financial Report Summary;

Upon motion by Director Stein, seconded by Director Manriquez, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Consent Agenda.

#### **CHAIR REPORT**

Chair Lents reported on the groundbreaking ceremony as the Authority moves into the construction phase of the Shepherd and Durham Reconstruction Project, Phase I, noting that it was well attended.

#### PRESIDENT REPORT

#### Update on Zone boundary change

Ms. Weesner updated the Board on the City action pertaining to the Zone boundary enlargement and Project Plan and Reinvestment Zone Financing Plan amendments. She advised it is on hold and will be pursued in the coming year.

#### Ratify approval of Funding Commitment for 2021 Off-System HSIP

Ms. Weesner reviewed with the Board a letter from the Authority to the City approving a funding commitment for the 2021 Off-System Highway Safety Improvement Program ("HISP") for the 19<sup>th</sup> Street, Beall Street, and Bevis Street corridors, which was provided to the City in November. She advised the commitment funds 10% of the project, with the HSIP Grant providing the remaining 90% of funding. Upon motion by Director Stein, seconded by Director Manriquez, and after full discussion, the Board voted unanimously to ratify approval of the funding commitment for the 2021 Off-System HISP.

#### Ratify approval of Agreement for Continuing Disclosure Services

Ms. Weesner reviewed with the Board an Agreement for Continuing Disclosure Services with Masterson Advisors LLC. Upon motion by Vice Chair Colom, seconded by Director Stein, and after full discussion, the Board voted unanimously to ratify approval of the Agreement.

#### 2022 Board Meeting Schedule

Ms. Lents reviewed the 2021 Board meeting schedule, noting that the Board will continue indefinitely the hybrid meeting format, with a quorum of Directors attending in-person at SKLaw, and remaining attendees attending electronically.

#### PROJECTS AND ENGINEERING

#### Receive Projects Committee Report

Ms. Weesner updated the Board on Authority projects.

#### Approve J|C Work Authorization No. 1 [FY2022][General Services]

Ms. Hennings reviewed with the Board Work Authorization No. 1 for general engineering services for fiscal year 2022 in the amount of \$25,000.00. Upon motion by Director Stein, seconded by Director Manriquez, and after full discussion, the Board voted unanimously to approve J|C Work Authorization No. 1 for 2022 general engineering services.

#### Shepherd and Durham Reconstruction

#### <u>Update on project development</u>

Ms. Hennings updated the Board on the Shepherd/Durham and Selected Cross Streets Reconstruction [CIP Project T-0523A] project.

#### Update on construction management and materials testing contract

Ms. Weesner stated that a contract is being negotiated with CDM Smith.

#### Approve J|C Work Authorization T-0523A No. 7

Ms. Hennings reviewed with the Board Work Authorization T-0523A No. 7 for construction phase services for Phase 2. She advised that the City requested the inclusion of a 21-inch sanitary sewer diversion in the final design, which will be funded by the City.

Upon motion by Director Stein, seconded by Vice Chair Colom, and after full discussion, the Board voted unanimously to approve J|C Work Authorization T-0523A No. 7.

#### North Canal Project

#### Update on project development

Ms. Weesner updated the Board on the North Canal Project [CIP Project T-0525], and discussed the various options being considered.

#### Yale and Center Street Intersection

#### Update on project development

Ms. Hennings updated the Board on the Yale and Center Street Intersection project [CIP Project T-0529], advising that preparation of 60% plans is ongoing, and are expected to be submitted to the City in January.

<u>Heights Boulevard Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Improvements, West Dallas Restriping Project, Trail Segment between White Oak Bayou and Memorial Park</u>

#### Update on project

Ms. Hennings updated the Board on the Heights Boulevard Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Improvements, West Dallas Restriping Project, Trail Segment between White Oak Bayou and Memorial Park [CIP T-0531].

#### Review bids and award construction contract

Ms. Hennings reviewed with the Board a letter of recommendation for award of construction bid. She advised four (4) bids were received, and the Projects Committee recommends the award to Teamwork Construction Services, Inc., and Texas Wall & Landscape, LLC, as alternate.

Upon motion by Director Stein, seconded by Vice Chair Colom, and after full discussion, the Board voted unanimously to authorize the Projects Committee to finalize a construction contract with Teamwork Construction Services, Inc., and as an alternate, Texas Wall & Landscape, LLC.

#### Zone Wide Safety and Mobility Projects

#### Update on project

Ms. Moran updated the Board on the Zone Wide Safety and Mobility Projects [CIP Project T-0532] and reviewed the mobility analysis. The Board discussed the data, and the best way to provide information to the public for input. The Board concurred that each Board member will provide input to Ms. Weesner for review.

#### Zone Wide Localized Stormwater Management Projects

#### Update on project

Mr. Moreda updated the Board on the Zone Wide Localized Stormwater Management Projects [CIP Project T-0533], and reviewed updated drainage data. Chair Lents discussed possible options that could be included in a future budget.

Mr. Nguyen reviewed possible future projects that can be partnered with surrounding entities.

#### Approve related contract administration items

The Board noted there are no contract administration items for consideration.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS**

#### Receive update on public relations firm contract

Director Manriquez reported in more detail on the groundbreaking ceremony for the Shepherd and Durham reconstruction project.

Director Manriquez then reviewed with the Board a proposal from Medley, Inc., for public relations and marketing services, including public relations services for events, such as the groundbreaking ceremony and preparation of a crisis management plan. He recommended that the Board approve the contract for a six-month period. Ms. Weesner advised that the fee for such services is \$2,000 per month, \$2,500 for the crisis management plan, and an additional \$5,500 for public relations services for three events.

Upon motion by Director Stein, seconded by Director Manriquez, and after full discussion, the Board voted unanimously to approve the contract with Medley, Inc., for a six-month period. The committee will review the work and the contract at 6 months and suggest any necessary changes.

#### **FINANCIAL MATTERS**

#### Receive Finance Committee Report

Vice Chair Colom next reported to the Board on financial matters.

#### Authorize payment of invoices

The Board reviewed the invoices submitted for payment. Director Brown advised that the Projects Committee had reviewed project-related invoices, and recommended approval. Vice Chair Colom advised that the Finance Committee had reviewed the invoices put before it and recommended approval. Following discussion of the invoices, a motion was made by Director Stein, seconded by Director Brown, and approved unanimously by the Board to authorize the payment of all invoices.

# Memorial Heights Redevelopment Authority Monthly Financial Report Summary April Board Meeting Thursday, April 28, 2022

At the beginning of December, the Memorial Heights Redevelopment Authority (TIRZ #5) beginning Operating Fund Balance was \$59,788,027. TIRZ #5 received a total of \$8,274, mainly from Money Market interest. During the period, TIRZ #5 processed \$3,205,281 in disbursements during the period. 74% of the disbursements related to disbursements to Jones & Carter for CIP Projects (\$1,160,918) and City of Houston Public for the North Canal High Flow Diversion (\$1,220,138). The ending balance as of month end March 31, 2022 was \$56,591,020.

The invoices pending approval total \$144,472. See attached "Unpaid Bills Detail" Report for invoices pending approval and invoices paid in between board meetings.

There was \$2,366,561 spent for Capital Projects for the period. The projects that utilized the majority of the funding was T-0523A Shepherd/Durham Reconstruction (\$1,062,333) and T-0525 Reconstruction Bridges White Oak (\$1,227,271). See attached "Capital Improvement Projects" Report on page 3.
