1,600' Extension of the White Oak Bayou Trail from Moy St. to Kansas St. (adjacent to TC Jester Blvd)

Routed through existing COH ROW next to the UPRR Eureka Yard

Work completed June 2022



























Conversion of ~600' of narrow, damaged sidewalk to 10'-wide shared use path

Construction of ADA ramps along path

Replacement of pavement markings from Washington Ave. to I-10

Work currently underway
