Conversion of ~600' of narrow, damaged sidewalk to 10'-wide shared use path

Construction of ADA ramps along path

Replacement of pavement markings from Washington Ave. to I-10

Work nearing completion

- Construction of two median islands to create "refuge" area for trail users crossing Houston Ave.
- Reconstruction of ADA ramps at trail crossing
 - Re-striping of intersection including crosswalks & installation of new signage
 - Concrete work complete


